The Seaview Font was named after one of my favorite parks in Dana Point, California. The styling of this font was partially inspired by the late 1700's Didot Typeface.

INSTALLING FONTS

If you are using a Mac, you can just drag the OTF font file into your font management software. (I use & recommend FontBook, which is a default program on every Mac).
